Leaving the Czech Republic, arrive in colorful and vibrant Vienna, Austria, the "musical city." Tonight's dinner is in one of

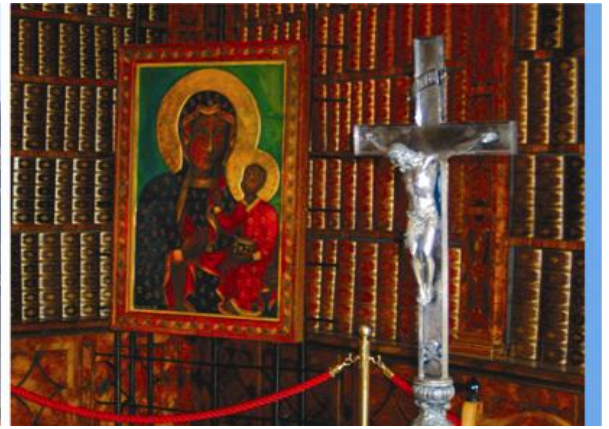

Sit back, relax and enjoy the picturesque Hungarian countryside en route to historic Budapest. Here, you'll discover Budapest, divided by the Danube with the historic Buda on one side and the cosmopolitan Pest on the opposite side. *Today breakfast and dinner will be included.*
